A TYPICAL DAY

A morning meeting starts the day with community-building, followed by academic instruction, small group learning, and integrated speech-language and occupational therapy support. Additional elements include Social-Emotional Learning Lab, outdoor education, art and music, and physical education, with sensory regulation and movement woven throughout the day.

SPECIALIZED SERVICES

Related Services are part of each student's Individualized Education Program (IEP), based on their specific needs. These supports are embedded into a student's experience through the support of a collaborative team: special education teacher, teacher associate, speech-language therapist, occupational therapist, social worker, counselor, and school psychologist, as appropriate.

FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

We build strong partnerships with families through regular communication, active participation in IEP planning, parent education, and collaborative problem-solving. By working together, we promote growth and independence.
